A Permit Engineering Evaluation Report (PEER) project to install raised median islands, sidewalks, street lighting, drainage, curb and gutter on State Route 62 (SR-62) between Apache Trail and Palm Avenue in the Town of Yucca Valley.

It is projected that the traffic volume on SR-62 will increase due to future developments. Improvements are needed to accommodate increasing traffic demand, and improve circulation and safety within the Town.
