CPUC Crossing No. 002-5.70

This request is for R/W Acquisitions of the parcels listed below located in the City of Barstow. R/W acquisitions is necessary for the future construction of an overhead structure over existing railroad tracks to separate the current at-grade crossing of Lenwood Road and BNSF railroad. Project is located in the City of Barstow located along Lenwood Road, north of West Main Street approximately 400 feet north of BNSF/UPPR to 600 feet south of BNSF/UPPR Right of Way.

A total of 37 parcels are considered for full take, partial take, and TCE. Seven (7) parcels involve relocation assistance- One (1) family and six (6) businesses.

SANBAG is the implementing agency. NEPA determination is a Categorical Exemption dated July 28, 2011. Reimbursed at 88.53% using L20E up to maximum federal amount.

05/18/2012 Sequence #1 is a request for right of way funding to administer the acquisition of 37 parcels and relocation of seven property owners for the construction of a 4-lane overhead to replace the existing 2-lane grade

crossing on Lenwood Road over the Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) Railroad tracks north of West Main Street in the community of Lenwood near the City of Barstow using Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds programmed in Amendment #21 approved on 2/15/12 to SCAG's 2010 FTIP. Federal funding is capped at \$3,450,000 for right of way administration, acquisition, and relocation activities with a maximum reimbursement ratio of 88.53%. Reimburse with L23E RSTP funds at approximately 40.6% up to the federal amount requested for right of way engineering and administration and at 88.53% up to the federal amounts requested for right of way acquisition and relocation.
