STATE REMARKS

THIS IS A REQUEST FOR CONSTRUCTION-ONLY FUNDING TO RECONSTRUCT THE I-10 AT RIVERSIDE AVENUE INTERCHANGE FROM SLOVER AVENUE TO VALLEY BOULEVARD IN RIALTO USING SAFETEA-LU DEMO FUNDS AND INTERSTATE MAINTENANCE DISCRETIONARY (IMD) FUNDS AWARDED IN FYS 02-03 AND 04-05 AND PROGRAMMED IN AMENDMENT #2 APPROVED ON 2/02/09 TO SCAG'S 2008 FTIP. WORK TO BE PERFORMED INCLUDE THE REPLACEMENT OF THE RIVERSIDE AVENUE OVERPASS AT I-10, RAMP WIDENING, AUXILIARY LANES ON I-10, AND CIRCULATION IMPROVEMENTS ON RIVERSIDE AVENUE AND VALLEY BOULEVARD. THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WILL BE ADMINISTERED BY SANBAG ON THE CITY OF RIALTO'S BEHALF. FUNDING FOR PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING WAS PREVIOUSLY OBLIGATED UNDER HP211M-5205(005), EA 08-412254L, USING TEA-21 DEMO FUNDS AWARDED UNDER DEMO ID #179, TEA-21 #1365, AND DESIGN COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT NO. 8-1050 EXECUTED BETWEEN CALTRANS AND RIALTO ON 5/05/99. ADDITIONAL PRELIMINARY FUNDING USING FY 01-02 Q020 IMD FUNDS WAS OBLIGATED BY CALTRANS UNDER IMD-0102(246), EA 08-422301S. CONSTRUCTION COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT NO. 8-1322 WAS EXECUTED AMONG CALTRANS, RIALTO, AND SANBAG ON 7/17/08 AND AMENDED UNDER COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT NO. 8-1322 A/1 ON 12/30/08 TO REVISE THE PROJECT POSTMILE LIMITS AND FUNDING. FHWA AGREED IN A 4/14/06 MEETING THAT ACCESS TO THE INTERSTATE WAS NOT MODIFIED AND THAT ACCESS ACCEPTABILITY WAS NOT REQUIRED. COMPLETE SUPPORT DOCUMENTATION WAS RECEIVED IN HQ ON 8/20/09 WHEN A FHWA MEMO DATED 8/18/09 RE-ALLOCATED THE IMD FUNDS FOR IMMEDIATE USE. A VALUE ANALYSIS STUDY WAS COMPLETED ON 3/08/06. FEDERAL FUNDING IS CAPPED AT \$4,296,890 FOR CONSTRUCTION WITH A MAXIMUM REIMBURSEMENT RATIO OF 80%. AN

The Office of Local Assistance, District 8 has reviewed your Request for Authorization for construction to reconstruct the I-10 at Riverside Avenue interchange from Slover Avenue to Valley Boulevard in Rialto. Work to be performed include the replacement of the Riverside Avenue overpass at I-10, ramp widening, auxiliary lanes on I-10, and circulation improvements on Riverside Avenue and Valley Boulevard. The construction contract will be administered by SANBAG on the City of Rialto's behalf.
